Project Transformation is looking for caring volunteers, ages 13 and up, to read with our summer day camp participants. The literacy component of Project Transformation is an exciting opportunity for volunteers to interact with our children in a one-to-one setting. Reading volunteers listen to each child read for 30 minutes. After reading, the pair engages in discussion and comprehension activities about the story. The reading component takes place at our day camp locations on Monday-Thursday from 9:30-12:00. The Reading Program is from the first week of June to the last week of July. We welcome both individuals and groups.
