To engage young adults in purposeful leadership and ministry, support underserved children and families, and connect churches to communities in need.

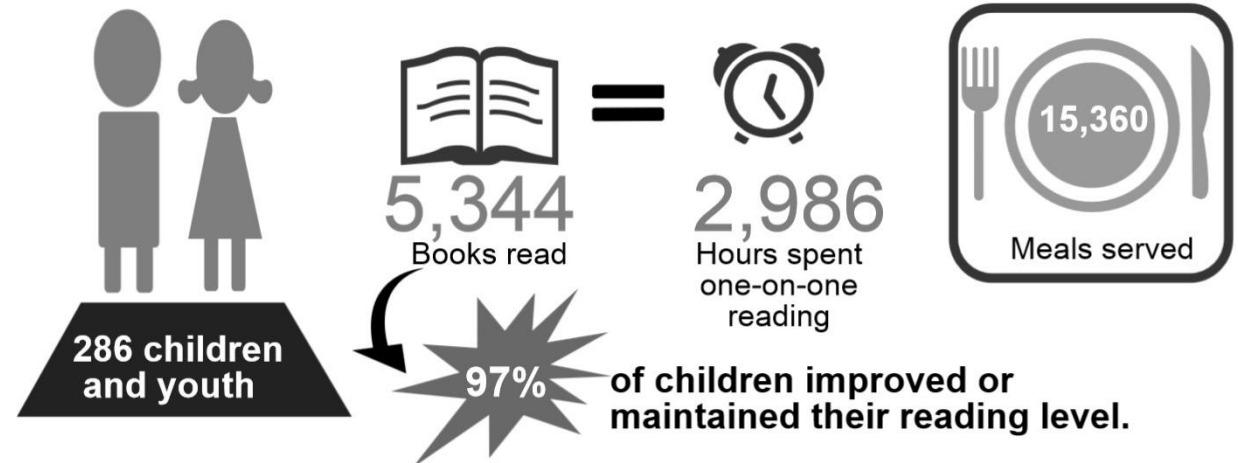

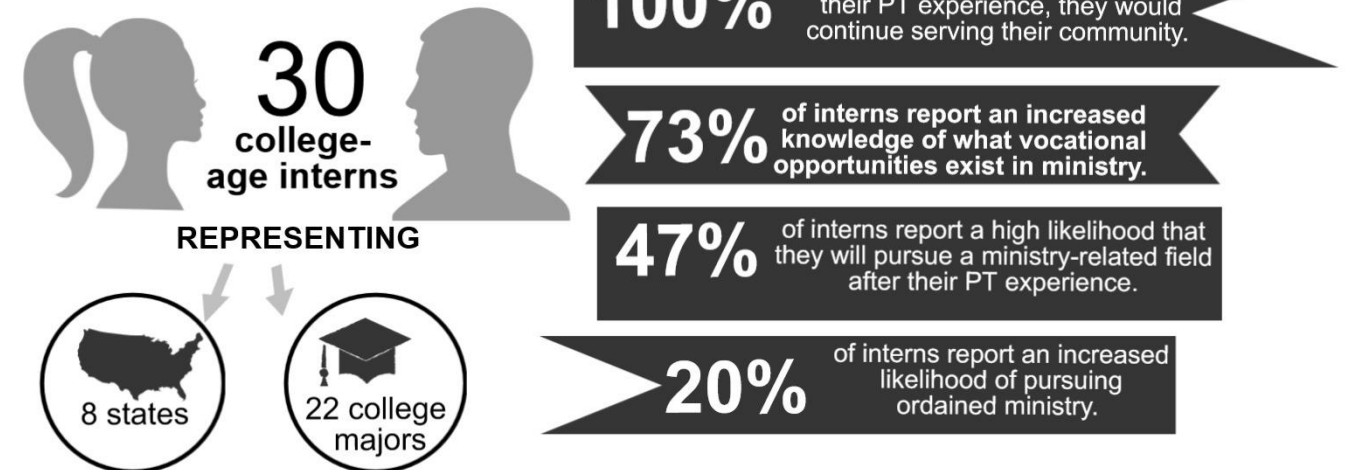

Summer Enrichment Program



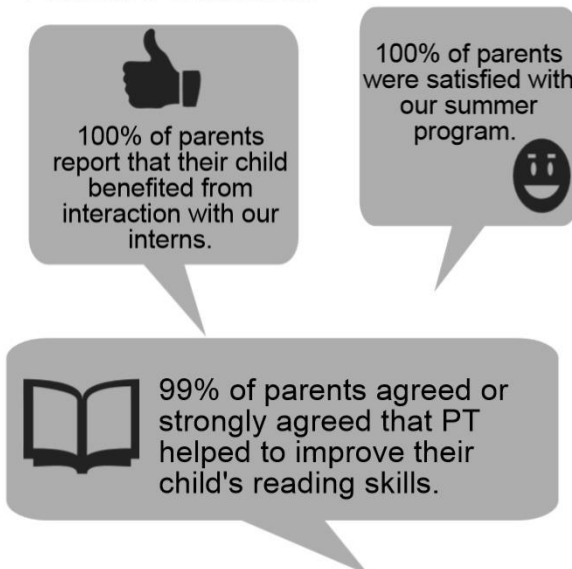
Our eight-week summer program operated Monday through Thursday from 9 am to 3 pm at five sites in West Nashville, East Nashville, and Antioch. Highlights for children (grades 1-6) included a daily reading program, a Bible lesson, nutritious meals, and enriching art and wellness activities. Our youth program (grades 6-9) focused on team-building and leadership development, book clubs, a Bible study, service projects, and learning about community needs.

Our interns served more than 15,000 hours this summer while planning and implementing summer programs for at-risk children and youth. They lived in intentional Christian community and explored vocational opportunities in ministry and service.
