Q3: Tell us about your past experiences with children and youth.

Q4: If you were having conflict with another intern or had a behavioral issue with one of our Summer Reading Camp students, what would be your first questions to yourself or the person you are concerned about?

Q5: How have faith and spirituality played a role in your life? How do you interact with people with different worldviews or beliefs?

Q6: What are you hoping to learn or achieve if you become an intern with Project Transformation Rio Texas? What goals or values do you wish to strengthen throughout this summer?
