**Summary:** Afterschool Homework Buddies offer mentorships to elementary children by offering genuine relationships, encouragement, and one-on-one homework and reading tutoring during out-of-school hours.

**Responsibilities:**

- Sign in at volunteer station each shift
- Recognize and affirms children's strengths, contribution, and achievement
- Assist students with homework
- Support students in reading, writing, and other literacy-based activities
- Complete a volunteer log following each session
- Help young adult Fellow track student progress

- Must be 13 years of age or older
