Support young lives in our community this summer.

Virtual Volunteers- We will need folks to work with our staff to check in and read with children. These folks will need to pass a background check before they can volunteer.

Packing Camp in a Bag- We need volunteers to help pack the supplies into the bags to be distributed. Packing will take place Tuesday morning in Baltimore at John Wesley UMC and Wednesday mornings in DC at Hughes Memorial. Volunteers need to be 18-64 and will need to fill out a health waiver every time they volunteer. We will also be taking temperatures before they enter the church.

Distribution Volunteers- Project Transformation will distribute a Camps in a Bag once a week. . A few in-person volunteers are needed to sanitize, organize, and distribute supplies. Volunteers must sign a waiver and be willing to have their temperature taken at arrival in order to serve every day they serve.
